July 18-20, 2000


DLMSO will chair Supply PRC (SPRC) meeting 00-2, July 18-20, 2000, beginning at 0900 on July 18, 2000. The meeting will be held at the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) Headquarters Complex (HQC), Fort Belvoir, VA (room 4905 on July 18-19 and room 3905 on July 20). A tentative agenda is at Attachment 1.

Tuesday, July 18, 2000, will be devoted to the maintenance repair and return (R&R) process as requested by the committee at SPRC meeting 00-1. To provide a basis for in-depth discussion of R&R, and the possible need to develop standard procedures to govern the process, each Component is asked to provide an overview briefing of their maintenance R&R process (both domestic and security assistance if they differ). Components are encouraged to bring maintenance subject matter experts for the discussion.

The HQC has implemented full security measures and all visitors must enter the building through the main entrance. (This is the entrance nearest the flag poles.) In addition, visitors must use the main entrance (Gate #1) to gain access to the HQC parking lot and to obtain a visitor's parking pass. Please confirm your attendance in advance so we may provide a list of attendees to the HQC security staff and assure that adequate conference room space is available.
