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2. During MILSTRIP Meeting 88-3, reference 1.b, Service/Agency comments on AMCL 169, reference 1.a, were discussed and resolved. Reference 1.c revealed that the Air Force Medical Logistics Office, on behalf of the Defense Medical Standardization Board, established the timeframe for reporting shelf-life PWR medical assets to begin at 18 months of remaining shelf life and reporting to stop at 6 months. Based on the above, revised procedures are submitted for review and determination of an implementation date. Reimbursement procedures for redistributed PWR medical assets are being developed by the DoD MILSBILLS Focal Point Committee. For purposes of this RFID, assume that the MILSBILLS AMCL will have the same implementation date.

3. Request the earliest preferred cyclic implementation date (1 May or 1 November) for the enclosed approved change be forwarded to this office, ATTN: DLSSO-BM, not later than 90 days from the date of this letter. Each Service preferred implementation date should be coordinated with their cognizant medical command. When a mutually satisfactory cyclic implementation date is determined, an approved MILSTRIP change letter (AMCL) with an established implementation date will be published.

4. It is also requested that the Services/Agencies provide a list of their activities authorized to requisition medical materiel to include DoDAACs. This list should cite both CONUS and OCONUS activities and will be used to update appendix D of reference 1.d.

5. The title of DoD 4000.25-1-S2, "Defense European and Pacific Redistribution Activity (DEPRA) Procedures," reference 1.d, will be changed to "Defense Program for Redistribution of Assets (DEPRA)." At republication of reference 1.d, the cover will be revised to reflect the name change. Publication contents of DoD 4000.25-1-S2 and other DoD publications will be revised to contain the new name as appropriate.

Approved MILSTRIP Change Letter (AMCL) 169A,  
Increasing Medical Support in DEPRA Procedures

1. Change chapter 4, paragraph B., to add subparagraph B.24:

24. Pre-positioned War Reserve (PWR) medical materiel with less than 6 months of remaining potency/shelf life. \*

2. Change chapter 4, paragraph B. to add subparagraph B. 25:

25. Exclusive of medical materiel, shelf-life materiel with less than 12 months remaining. \*

3. Change chapter 8, paragraph D.2. to read:

2. Policy

a. Medical materiel excess to the authorized retention levels or medical materiel in pre-positioned war reserve stock accounts with 18 months of remaining shelf life but not less than 6 months of remaining shelf life will be reported. \*

b. Authorized CONUS activities requisitioning medical items will be included as DEPRA participants. \*

c. Requisitioners of PWR medical materiel reported through DEPRA will pay full price. \*

4. Change chapter 8 to add new subparagraph D.3.a.(4):

(4) All PWR medical materiel that falls within the designated shelf-life criterion for redistribution will be reported except:

(a) PWR materiel stored at remote locations. \*

(b) PWR materiel preconfigured as sets, kits, and outfits. \*

(c) Medical materiel undergoing FDA processing or extension. \*

(d) Medical materiel requiring special handling. \*

(e) Medical materiel requiring refrigeration. \*

(f) Medical materiel which is corrosive or inflammable. \*

5. Change chapter 8 to add new subparagraphs D.3.c.(5) and D.3.c.(6):

(5) Priority medical requisitions 01-03 will be excluded from the DEPRA redistribution process. \*

(6) Redistribution of medical items with less than 18 months of remaining shelf life shall not be made to fill war reserve or ~~normal stock replenishment~~ requirements. *delete* \*

6. Change chapter 8, paragraph D.3.d.(2) to read:

(2) In order to ensure DEPRA ability to redistribute expiration dated items with sufficient remaining life to cover time for delivery and normal consumption by the requisitioners, holding activities will submit FTCs to DEPRA when the remaining shelf life reaches 6 months. When remaining life reaches 6 months, holding activities will not ship items with less than 6 months remaining potency/shelf life without concurrence from the receiving activity. \*

7. Change chapter 8 to add paragraph D.3.d.(3):

(3) To the maximum extent possible, items being redistributed to fill CONUS requirements should be shipped using transportation priority (TP)-4. *(See MILSTAMP (reference (P))).?* \*

8. Change chapter 8 to add subparagraph D.3.e. as follows:

e. Billing/Collection:

Billing/collection of redistributed PWR medical assets will be accomplished under DoD 4000.25-7-M, Military Standard Billing Systems (MILSBILLS) procedures. \*
