Reference (a) approved procedures to limit the use of exception data requisitions and established categories of requisitions authorized to use exception ship-to addresses. Reference (b) authorized implementation of AMCL 2 at anytime with the exception that reject code D6 would not be used until November 1, 1992. Reference (c) included AMCL 2 in MILSTRIP and noted that reject code D6 could not be used until November 1, 1992. Reference (d) requested another category of requisitions be authorized to use exception data ship-to addresses.

The request of reference (d) is approved. The next formal change to MILSTRIP will include the following category of requisitions authorized to use exception data ship-to addresses:


