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

1. Revise chapter 3, subparagraph BB.1.a, to read:

"a. First, against backorders in the following order of assigned status codes: BB, BC, BD, BZ, and BV."

2. Revise chapter 3, subparagraph CC.4.a, second sentence, to read:

"This applies to items/quantities in Status Code BZ."
