MEMORANDUM FOR: SUPPLY PRC MEMBERS

SUBJECT: Approved DLMS Change 62A, Addendum for Revision to DLMS Supplement (DS) 856R, Shipment Status Material Returns (Supply)

This addendum provides a revision to the DoD 4000.25-M, Defense Logistics Management System (DLMS), modifying the DS 856R, Shipment Status Material Returns to correct an oversight and improve desired consistency and functionality among like transactions. This change is to be incorporated with Approved DLMS Change 62 during implementation. This change is required to support continued logistics operation in a DLMS/DLSS environment.

The updated DS will be posted to the DLMSO web site (<http://www.dla.mil/j-6/dlms0/ICs/Default.htm>) within 30 days from the above date for implementation planning. DLMSO will concurrently pursue coordination/approval with the DoD Logistics Functional Working Group, the DoD Electronic Data Interchange Standards Management Committee (EDISMC), and the Federal EDI Standards Management Coordinating Committee (FESMCC) for Federal implementation convention (IC) revisions. [This change is not associated with a DAAS implementation date.]
