**3. REQUESTED CHANGE:**

**a. Title:** Revision to DS 511R to Identify Ordered By Activity

**b. Description of Change:** This change revises a 511R DS DLMS note for qualifier OB in the table 2 N101 segment for clarification and to expand its functionality to identify the original requisitioner when a Management Control Activity is identified as the transaction From activity. In addition to the above 511R DS change, DAAS conversion maps for the DS 511M and the 869F are revised to always populate the OB Ordered By activity when the transaction From activity is other than the requisitioner. The transaction submitter will be carried in header/address loop and the Ordered By activity will be reflected in the detail data. (This requires no change to the 511M or 869F DSs.)

**c. Procedures:** Revise DLMS Supplements as indicated.
