SUBJECT: Approved Addendum to Approved Defense Logistics Management System (DLMS) Change (ADC) 167A, New Transaction Originator Code (TOC) Designating DoD E-MALL for use in DLMS Supplement (DS) 888W, Weapon System Data Change (Supply)

**Addendum to ADC 167A**  
**New TOC Designating DoD E-MALL for use in DS 888W, Weapon System Data Change**

**1. ORIGINATING SERVICE/AGENCY AND POC INFORMATION:**

- a. **Service/Agency:** Defense Logistics Agency (DLA)
- b. **Originator:** DLA J-3314 DSN 427-1612

**2. FUNCTIONAL AREA:**

- a. **Primary/Secondary Functional Area:** Supply/Logistics
- b. **Primary/Secondary Functional Process:** EMALL

**3. REFERENCES:**

- a. DLAM 4140.2, Supply Operation Manual, Vol II Part 3, Appendix A-22
- b. DLMSO Memorandum dated June 13, 2005, subject: Approved DLMS Change (ADC) 167, Component Unique Data Content within DS 888W, Weapon System Data Change.

**4. REQUESTED CHANGE:**

a. **Description of Change:** This change provides a new value for the Transaction Origination Code (TOC) to be recognized on DLMS transactions associated with the Weapon Systems Support Program (WSSP) as indicating that the transaction originated within DoD EMALL. This change is an addendum to approved procedures documented under ADC 167.

b. **Background:** Currently all transactions coming from WSSP in DoD EMALL have the Routing Identifier(RIC)-From SME assigned to the DLMS Weapon System Data Change (888W/Document Identifier WS1) transaction. When DLA's Enterprise Business System (EBS) reads this transaction and sees the RIC SME, EBS will put RIC-To SME on the responding DLMS 888W (Document Identifier WS3), and the Defense Automatic Addressing System (DAAS) will direct the transaction to EMALL.

c. **Detailed Procedures:** If a new TOC E indicating DoD EMALL was created, EMALL would populate the "E" in the TOC on the WS1 with the correct Military Service RIC as the RIC-From. EBS would correctly post the user's RIC as the RIC-From Service and create the WS3 with the RIC-From on the WS1 as the RIC-To on the WS3 and perpetuate the TOC E. When DAAS receives DLMS 888W/WS3 transactions, an edit would be added so that if the TOC E is present the transaction will be routed to DoD EMALL, instead of routing the transaction to the RIC-To.

5. **REASON FOR CHANGE:** To allow DAAS to route the appropriate WS3 to EMALL.

6. **ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:**

a. **Advantages:** This will allow transactions coming from WSSP in EMALL to have a unique TOC where DAAS can identify and transmit all transactions with a TOC “E” directly to EMALL

b. **Disadvantages:** None

c. **Alternatives:** DLMSO identified an alternative where by current RIC-From/RIC-To would be unchanged, however an additional RIC value would be added to the DLMS format. This would allow for identification of the submitting Service and would allow routing to EMALL without DAAS intervention.

d. **Planned Implementation Date:** Implementation is planned for June, 2010. DOD EMALL is planning this to go into our 10.3.3 release, dated 12 June 2010

## 7. IMPACT:

**a. DLMS Data Elements:** Add new code value to Weapon System Transaction Origination Code : E – DoD EMALL.

**b. DAAS:** Requires a program change in DAAS Micro Automated Routing System. (DMARS) to route WS3s with "E" in the TOC position to DoD EMALL, while routing all others to the RIC-TO.

**c. DLIS DoD EMALL:** Revise DoD EMALL procedures to show Military Service RIC as originator and include TOC E on outgoing DLMS 888W/WS1. Revise DoD EMALL procedures to receive incoming DLMS 888W/WS3 with Military Service RI-To and TOC E, and properly post.
