MILSTRIP ACP/ACM Cancellation Formats

2. FUNCTIONAL AREA: Primary: Supply (Order Processing)

3. REFERENCE: DLMSO memorandum, dated June 2, 2008, subject: ADC 286, Administrative Update for MILS/DLMS Conversion for MILSTRIP ACP/ACM Cancellation Formats

4. REQUESTED CHANGE:

a. **Description of Change:** The ADC 286 was provided to correct conversion mapping between two MILSTRIP cancellation formats, the ACP and ACM, which are mapped to DLMS Supplement (DS) 869C, Requisition Cancellation. ADC 286B identifies an additional update.

b. Procedures:

(1) **Background:** The ACP/ACM transaction format is identified in MILSTRIP Appendix 3.9, Supply Source Cancellation (Direct Delivery from Procurement) and defined as follows:

ACM	Cancellation	From ICP to procurement activity. Results from the receipt of a universal cancellation request
ACP	Cancellation	From ICP to procurement activity. Cancellation for indicated quantity of the item listed on the procurement instrument or procurement document designated by the number in rp 62-74

(2) **Detailed Change:** DAAS documentation and system maps for MILS/DLMS conversion must be updated to support current MILSTRIP requirements. **ADC 286B Addendum update is shown at paragraph (c) below.**

(a) **ADC 286.** Currently ACP/ACM rp 45-50 is mapped to DLMS Supplemental Address (2/LQ 01/180 Qualifier A9). However, the ACP/ACM format does not have a supplemental address; it has a New Consignee DoDAAC data field in rp 45-50. Update the DAAS logical and system map to equate rp 45-50 to the 869C N1/Consignee (which has the note indicating it is used for the consignee to whom material is diverted).

(b) **ADC 286.** The Procurement Request Number from the ACP/ACM (rp 51-64 when rp 65-69 is blank) is not mapped to the DLMS; it should be mapped to the 2/REF01/105

Qualifier W4 and REF02= rp 51-64 when rp 65-69 is blank.

(c) **ADC 286B.** Currently, the neither the DLMS Supplement nor the DAAS map indicates a specific data element as the party to receive the transaction per the MILSTRIP ACP/ACM format (rp 4-6). The DS 869C is updated as follows.

5. REASON FOR CHANGE:

a. **ADC 286.** USTRANSCOM personnel supporting Global Transportation Network Pre-Planned Product Improvement (GTN P31) identified a gap between MILSTRIP ACP/ACM and the equivalent DLMS. DAAS query results revealed that the ACP/ACM is not in use at this time, although the Army has confirmed that requirements.

b. **ADC 286B.** While pursuing the corrections provided under ADC 286, DAASC identified the additional issue of the lack of the mapping for the “To” address.

6. ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:

a. **Advantages:** Corrects transaction conversion at DAAS and map documentation for future systems developers.

b. **Disadvantages:** N/A
