

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2. The enclosed change to reference 1.b is established as Approved MILSTRIP Change Letter (AMCL) 33. The Services/Agencies provided their implementation dates as requested by reference 1.a. Based on Service/Agency responses, AMCL 33 will have staggered implementation dates. These dates are as follows: 1 May 1990 for GSA; 1 November 1990 for Army and NSA; 1 May 1991 for Coast Guard; 1 November 1991 for Navy and DLA; 1 November 1993 for Air Force; and 1 November 1994 for Marine Corps.
3. AMCLs containing the same cyclic implementation dates will be incorporated into an interim/formal MILSTRIP change immediately preceding the implementation date. Addressees are advised that specific paragraph/appendix numbering may be changed in the interim/formal change due to the long lead time involved for implementation.
4. This change meets the criteria set forth in the reference 1.c moratorium memorandum for continued processing to completion and establishment of an implementation date.

Clarification of Requirements for MOV Reports

1. References:

a. Draft report on the audit of the Validation of Requirements for Unfilled Materiel Orders (DoD Project 7SL-050). (NOTAL).

b. DoD 4000.25-1-M, 1 May 1987, Military Standard Requisitioning and Issue Procedures (MILSTRIP), as amended.

2. Change Concept/Rationale:

a. Concept: To change the requirements of the Quarterly Report, Validation of Overage Materiel Obligations, to reflect only cancellation actually requested by the requisitioner via the MOV response.

b. Rationale: Reference 1.a identified problem areas in the validation of certain requirements and in the MOV responses and reports. The MOV responses and reports were including partial shipments and cancellations that were not a result of the validation process.

3. Interface/Impact Requirements:

a. Interface: Between DoD MILSTRIP users and individual DoD Service/Agency procedures.

b. Impact: Changes are required to MILSTRIP and Service/Agency procedures.

4. Advantages/Disadvantages:

a. Advantages: This change will clarify the procedures for reporting MOV program results.

b. Disadvantages: See Impact paragraph.

5. Procedures: See attachment 1.

Attachment to Approved MILSTRIP Change 33,  
Clarification of Requirements for MOV Reports

Add the following to Chapter 7, paragraph E.3.:

"The supply source will review the history file prior to the preparation of the report for those transactions on which the quantity response was different from the quantity requested. This review will be made to determine if the quantity difference was a result of a shipment, a cancellation, or if the requisitioner actually requested the obligation to be canceled. Only cancellations actually requested by the requisitioner via the MOV response will be included in the MOV Report. Difference of quantity, as the result of any other cause/process, will not be reported."
