Approved MILSTRIP Change 148,
Required Delivery Period (RDP)

1. Add the following definition to paragraph 1-10:

"Required Delivery Period (RDP). A period of time which specifies the earliest and last acceptable date materiel can be delivered (applies to conventional ammunition requisitions only)."

2. Add the following as paragraph 2-1L:

"2-1L. Requisitions for conventional ammunition that should not be delivered before a specific date nor later than a specific date may contain a Required Delivery Period (RDP) in cc 62-64. The formula for expressing an RDP is provided in Appendix B14.

(NOTE: FMS and Grant Aid requisitions are excluded from RDP procedures.)

3. Revise paragraph 2-41b(7) to add "Required Delivery Period, cc 62-64 (conventional ammunition only)" after the required delivery date entry.

4. Amend paragraph 3-1a to include the following edits for the RDP field (reference RDD edits as published in AMCL 108):

Entry in Card Column Blank or Incorrect

Required Delivery Period

If there is an alpha B, C, D, G, H, J,
K, L, M, P, T, U, V, or W in cc 62, and
a numeric 01 thru 99 in cc 63-64, process.

5. Add the following to paragraph 3-1c:

"(8) Required Delivery Period in cc 62-64 if later than the computed Standard Delivery Date - conventional ammunition only."

6. Add a new paragraph 3-12 as follows:

"3-12 Supply Source Processing of RDP Requisitions (conventional ammunition only)

a. Requisitions with an RDP that has an earliest delivery date that is within the standard UMMIPS Time frames for the PD will be processed in accordance with the time period established for that PD.

b. Requisitions with an RDP that has an earliest delivery date that is longer than the standard UMMIPS time frames for the PD will not be placed on backorder. If stock is not available, the requisition will be referred or rejected back to the customer. If stock is available, an MRO will be issued to the storage facility.

The shipping activity will establish necessary control mechanisms to provide timely shipment to the customer.

c. Requisitions that cannot be delivered within the RDP will be rejected with Status Code CB.

d. RDP procedures do not apply to FMS or Grant Aid requisitions.

7. Change the title of existing paragraph 3-38 from "Materiel Release Denials (Warehouse Refusals)" to "Storage Activity Denial or Rejection of Materiel Releases." Renumber existing paragraph 3-38 as paragraph 3-38a, and add new paragraph 3-38b as follows:

"b. If the storage activity cannot meet the delivery time frame specified by the Required Delivery Period (RDP) in cc 62-64, DI Code AE6 status with Status Code CB will be provided to the supply source. The supply source will advise eligible status recipients (applies to conventional ammunition requisitions only)."

8. Add the following to paragraph 8-1e:

"(6) RDP entry (cc 62-64) when associated with the "ship to" address (Requisitioner, cc 30-35 or Supplementary Address, cc 45-50) being cancelled - conventional ammunition only."

9. Change "required delivery date" to "required delivery date/required delivery period," and "RDD" to "RDD/RDP" in the following paragraphs: 3-1c(6), 3-6d, 3-56, 4-31a, 5-3a, 7-12b(2), and 8-1f.

10. Change appendix B14 as follows:

"n. For conventional ammunition requisitions only, when materiel is required to be delivered within a specific time period (i.e., the materiel is for an exercise and the materiel is not required before or after the exercise) a Required Delivery Period (RDP) may be established as outlined below and entered in cc 62-64:

(1) Decide the last acceptable delivery date, then calculate how many days this date is past the date of the requisition. Assign this number of days to the last two positions of the RDP code (cc 63-64). (The RDP allows the last acceptable delivery date to reach up to but not exceed 99 days past the date of the requisition).

(2) Decide the earliest acceptable delivery date. Determine how many days this date is before the last acceptable delivery date. Match this number to the corresponding letter in the RDP table below. Assign this letter to the first position of the RDP code (cc 62). (The RDP code allows the earliest acceptable delivery date up to, but not greater than, 14 days before the last acceptable delivery date.)

(3) In the above manner, a requisitioner may specify a required delivery period without the use of exception data. As an example, assume a requisition has a Julian date of 9125, and the last acceptable delivery date is 30 days after the date of the requisition (i.e., 9155), while the earliest acceptable delivery date is 2 days before the last acceptable delivery date (i.e., 9153). In this case, the last two positions of the RDP code would be '30', and the first position would be 'C' (i.e., 2 days before 9155, the last acceptable delivery date). The RDP code would appear on the requisition as 'C30.'

11. Change appendix B16 as follows:

Change the explanation of Status Code CB to read:

"Rejected. Initial requisition requested rejection of the quantity not available for immediate release or not available by the SDD or RDD, or within the RDP (for conventional ammunition). Quantity field indicates quantity not filled."

12. Change the following appendices, field legends for card columns 62-64 to read, "Required Delivery Date/Required Delivery Period":

- C-1. Requisition Card Entries.
- C-6. Supply Source Cancellation Card Entries.
- C-11. Materiel Release Order/Followup Card Entries.
- C-21. Referral Order Card Entries.
- C-22. Redistribution Order Card Entries.

13. Change the following appendices, punched card layouts for card columns 62-64 to read, "Required Delivery Date/Required Delivery Period-conventional ammunition only."

- D1-1. Requisition.
- D2-1. Followup (No Supply Status Received).
- D2-2. Followup (Supply Status Received).
- D3-1. Cancellation (No Supply Status Received).
- D3-2. Cancellation (Supply Status Received).

- D4-1. Supply Source Cancellation (Issues from Stock).
- D4-2. Supply Source cancellation (Direct Delivery from Procurement).
- D5-2. Materiel Release Order.
- D6-3. Materiel Release Denial (Warehouse Refusal).
- D7-3. Referral Order.
- D8-1. Passing Order.
- D8-2. Redistribution Order.
