4. REQUESTED CHANGE(S):

a. **Brief Overview of Change:**

(1) This change makes an administrative update to DLM 4000.25, Volume 2 (reference 3.a.), adding Appendix 11 to identify the correlation of MILSTRAP legacy document identifier code (DIC) functionality to DLMS implementation convention (IC) coding. DLMSO has an ongoing initiative to incorporate the MILSTRAP manual (Reference 3.b.) into the Defense Logistics Management System manual, Volume 2. The current process of maintaining two sets of publications (DLM 4000.25, Volume 2/MILS), which contain essentially the same procedures for two different transaction formats (i.e., the Accredited Standards Committee (ASC) X12 formats and the legacy 80-record position formats), is resource intensive and duplicative in nature. This change better positions DLM 4000.25, Volume 2 and MILSTRAP for future movement to a combined manual.

(2) The existing DLM 4000.25, Volume 2, addresses MILSTRAP legacy transactions throughout the volume, but does not specifically identify the correlation of MILSTRAP legacy DIC functionality to the individual DLMS IC beginning segment coding. Appendix 11 is being added to DLM 4000.25, Volume 2, to provide the reference to MILSTRAP legacy DIC functionality and the DLMS IC.

b. Revisions to DLM 4000.25 series of manuals:

(1) Revise DLM 4000.25, Volume 2, to add Appendix 11, Correlation of MILSTRAP Legacy DIC Functionality to DLMS Implementation Convention Coding, as shown in the enclosure.

(2) Revise the Volume 2 Table of Contents to include Appendix 11.

5. REASON FOR CHANGE: Provide a user aid to correlate MILSTRAP legacy DIC functionality to DLMS IC coding, in the DLM 4000.25, Volume 2 , which contains procedures related to MILSTRAP.

6. ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:

a. **Advantages:** Makes it easier for users to find the MILSTRAP legacy transaction functionality relationship to DLMS ICs, when using DLM 4000.25, Defense Logistics Management System, Volume 2.

b. **Disadvantages:** None

7. ESTIMATED TIME LINE/IMPLEMENTATION TARGET: Administrative publication update with no system impact. Publication of this change is targeted for Formal Change 5 to Defense Logistics Management System, Volume 2.

AP11. APPENDIX 11

Correlation of MILSTRAP Legacy DIC Functionality to DLMS Implementation Convention Coding

AP11.1. This appendix provides a user aid for Military Standard Transaction Reporting and Accountability Procedures (MILSTRAP). The aid consists of correlation tables between MILSTRAP legacy document identifier code (DIC) series, (e.g., D4_, D6_, D7_, etc.) and DLMS implementation conventions (IC), which provide general functional equivalency between each MILSTRAP DIC and DLMS IC. In addition to identification of the DIC/DLMS basic cross-references, physical location of the applicable transaction type code(s) within each DLMS IC and clarifying information required to define a valid correlation are provided:
