**SUBJECT:** Approved Addendum to Defense Logistics Management Standards (DLMS) Standards (ADC) 1121A, Wide Area Workflow (WAWF) Update to Add Local Stock Number to Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) Enterprise Business System (EBS) Edits When Serving as the Payment System (Supply/Contract Administration)

The attached change to DLM 4000.25, Defense Logistics Management Standards, is approved for immediate implementation. The Invoice, Receipt, Acceptance and Property Transfer (iRAPT) Operational Requirements Committee (ORC) approved the addition of local stock number to the EBS edits, when it is the payment system. IRAPT released this change to production in April 2015.

**When Serving as the Payment System**

**4. APPROVED CHANGE:**

- a. **Overview of Change:** This addendum updates the edits applied to Product/Service pairs for DLA Enterprise Business System (EBS) to add Qualifier SW defined as Local Stock Number

to the list of product/service ID qualifiers when the payment system is EBS. All other previously approved DLMS changes released under ADC 1121 (see Reference 3.a.) remain in effect.

**b. Background:**

(1) The Invoicing, Receipt, Acceptance, and Property Transfer (iRAPT) module of the WAWF eBusiness Suite is a DOD mandated system that allows the vendor to electronically submit invoices and receiving reports, and the Government to inspect, receive, accept information, and pay electronically.

(2) ADC 1121 (see Reference 3.a.) provided implementation procedures to support requirements identified in Reference 3.b. It permitted up to fifteen (15) “Product/Service ID Qualifier” and corresponding “Product/Service ID” combinations (referred to as “product/service pairs”) in WAWF 856 transactions. Product/service pairs are used to identify/describe the commodity or service under contract as reported on the WAWF Receiving Report (RR), Energy Receiving Report (ERR), Repairable Receiving Report (RRR), Purchase Card RR, Property Transfer, and DLMS Advance Shipment Notice. Similar changes were also made to the WAWF 857 Shipment and Billing Notice (also known as the COMBO).

(3) Subsequent to the implementation of ADC 1121, DLA Aviation identified a need to update the business rules associated with EBS edits, when EBS is the payment system. Specifically, Local Stock Number needed to be added as a product/service ID to the list of qualifiers, one of which must be present to support billing by EBS. This requirement was submitted to the iRAPT program management office as a quick change under Reference 3.c. This change impacts business logic in iRAPT and EBS.

**c. Approved Change in Detail:** Revise WAWF processing to apply the following edits to the Product/Service pairs for DLA EBS. If the payment system is EBS, at least one of the following Product/Service ID qualifiers is required:

- FS – National Stock Number (NSN)
- IB – International Standard Book Number (ISBN)
- MG – Manufacturer’s Part Number
- N4 – National Drug Code in 5-4-2 Format
- *SW – Local Stock Number (LSN)*
- UK – U.P.C./EAN Shipping Container Code (1-2-5-5-1)
- UX – Universal Product Number
- VC – Vendor's (Seller's) Catalog Number
- VP – Vendor's (Seller's) Part Number

**d. Transaction Flow:** This change does not impact existing transaction flow.

**e. Revisions to DLM 4000.25 Manuals:** There are no changes required to any DLM manuals.

**f. Alternatives:** None identified.

Concur with Comment  Per DLA, when EBS is the payment system, at least one of the product/service pairs identified in this DLMS change must be present; that doesn't preclude the others from being present. If one of these is not present when EBS is the payment system, there will be an edit failure.

**5. REASON FOR CHANGE:** WAWF release 5.6 of November 2014 updated the edit on product/service ID FS (National Stock Number) to prevent alpha characters. DLA's EBS system has a need to receive product IDs that have alpha characters, such as local stock numbers. Product/service ID Qualifier SW (Local Stock Number) was implemented in iRAPT under Release 5.6 in April 2015; however, the business rule edits for required edits associated with EBS when EBS is the payment system were not identified.

**6. ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:**

**a. Advantages:** Local Stock Numbers are utilized by Navy sites supported by DLA and more Long Term Contracts are being created for LSNs requiring the use of the SW qualifier in iRAPT.

**b. Disadvantages:** None identified

**7. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS TO CONSIDER:** The addition of Product/Service ID SW (Local Stock Number) will not adversely affect the current processes supporting Inventory

Management and Stock Positioning (IMSP) (see ADC 387 under Reference 3.d.), DLA Disposition Services (see ADC 457 under Reference 3.e.), and Small Arms/Light Weapons associated with DLA Disposition Services (see ADC 1019 under Reference 3.f.), all of which already implemented procedures using LSN.

**8. ESTIMATED TIME LINE/IMPLEMENTATION TARGET:** The iRAPT Operational Requirements Committee (ORC) approved the addition of product/service ID SW to the EBS edits. This is scheduled to be released to production in April 2015.

**9. IMPACT:**

**a. DLMS Data Elements:** There are no additions or changes to DLMS data elements.

**b. Automated Information Systems (AIS):**

(1) iRAPT will be updated to accommodate the updated EBS business rule to provide required output to EBS.

(2) EBS will be updated to receive local stock numbers from iRAPT.

**c. DLA Transaction Services:** No impact to the Global Exchange (GEX).

**d. Non-DLA Logistics Management Standards Publications:** The WAWF Program Management Office will update any guidelines/documentation to support this edit change.
