

Approved MILSTRIP Change Letter (AMCL) 161

Unit of Issue in Materiel Management

1. Change 3-7 thru 3-10 RESERVED to read 3-7 thru 3-9 RESERVED.
2. Add new paragraph 3-10 to read as follows:

3-10 SUPPLY SOURCE PROCESSING OF REQUISITIONS WITH ADVICE CODES 2D, 27, or 29.

Upon receipt of any requisition displaying an advice code of 2D, 27 or 29, an edit will be performed to determine if an increase in the requisition quantity to the Quantity Unit Pack is less or more than \$5.00. If less than \$5.00, the advice code will be disregarded. If \$5.00 or more, the advice code will be honored and processed for the exact quantity requested. When a quantity adjustment is made using the above criteria, the customer will be notified using MILSTRIP Status code BJ.

3. Change the parenthetical note following the explanation of Advice code 2D in appendix B15 to read:

"(i.e., do not adjust to quantity unit pack unless adjustment is upward and the dollar value increase is not more than \$5.00 over the requisition's extended money value.)"
