MEMORANDUM FOR SUPPLY PROCESS REVIEW COMMITTEE

SUBJECT: Withdrawal of Approved DLMS Change (ADC) 140, Revise DS 527R, Receipt, Inquiry, Response and MRA to Acknowledge Navy Requirement for Shipper Routing Identifier (RI) Code in Support of Navy Commercial Asset Visibility (CAV) - Organic Repairables Module (Supply)

This announces the formal withdrawal of Approved DLMS Change (ADC) 140, dated January 10, 2005. ADC 140 added the Shipper RI Code to DS 527R receipt transaction in support of Navy CAV using qualifier "SF-Ship From". However, it was later determined that the addition of qualifier SF was duplicative of the purpose of existing qualifier "CI-Consignor".

This withdrawal action is based upon ADC 216, dated November 7, 2006, which revised DLMS Supplement 527R receipt in support of CAV, and deleted qualifier "SF-Ship From" and its associated notes from the DLMS Supplement. The Navy CAV II Interface Design Description indicates that the consignor who shipped the materiel is mapped to "CI-Consignor" vice "SF-Ship From." During staffing of ADC 216, as Proposed DLMS Change (PDC) 233, DLMSO noted that Qualifier "SF" was added to 527R for CAV use by ADC 140, but duplicated the purpose of "CI" and that ADC 140 would be withdrawn upon approval of PDC 233.
