2. 3. REQUESTED CHANGE:

- a. **Title:** Administrative Update to DLMS Supplement 824R, Reject Advice
- b. **Description of Change:**

(1) This change revises DS 824R, Reject Advice, to acknowledge qualifiers approved in version 5040, or version 5050, for the 2/REF/020 segment which equate to beginning segment codes of transactions being rejected by DS 824R. These qualifiers address beginning segment information which is used by some DLMS transactions but that is not covered by the 824R 2/OTI/010 Original Transaction Information (OTI) segment.

(2) As noted in referenced ADC 179, the existing OTI segment provides for beginning segment codes for data element 640-Transaction Type Code; 306-Action Code; and 641-Status Reason code, for use in uniquely identifying the transaction being rejected. However, not all DLMS transactions have these codes in the beginning segment. The following beginning segment data elements used in DLMS transactions within the DS 824R scope for rejection are not addressed in the OTI segment: **675 - Schedule Type Qualifier; 755 - Report Type Code; 783 - Planning Schedule Type Code; and 850 Status Report Code.** A means to provide this beginning segment information, to assist in uniquely identifying the transaction being rejected, was added to the REF segment using pseudo codes by ADC 179. Data element **529 - Inventory Transaction Type Code**, was also added to the REF segment to assist in uniquely identifying DS 947I transactions being rejected. DLMSO submitted data maintenance requests to the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) Accredited Standards Committee (ASC) X12, to add the missing codes to the OTI segment, however, ASC X12 nonconcurred with adding more qualifiers to OTI, in favor of using the REF segment for the information. This approach was consistent with the interim approach DLMSO had taken to use the REF segment to provide the information.

c. **Procedures:** Revise DS 824R, Reject Advice, to update DLMS notes to acknowledge qualifiers ASC X12 approved for version 5040 or 5050:

4. REASON FOR CHANGE: This change identifies in DS 824R, ANSI ASC X12 Data ID 128 Reference Identification Qualifiers approved in ASC X12 version 5040 or 5050, which can be used in the DS 824R REF segment to identify information from the beginning segment of the transaction being rejected by DS 824R. This information will assist in uniquely identifying the transaction being rejected. DLMSO originally submitted data maintenance requesting that the qualifiers be approved for the Original Transaction Identification (OTI) segment (824R - 2/OTI/010), however ASC X12 favored including the information in the REF segment. Use in the REF segment achieves the same DLMS goal, and was in fact the interim approach DLMSO pursued, using pseudo codes, while waiting for ANSI review of the data maintenance requests submitted for the OTI segment.

5. ADVANTAGES/DISADVANTAGES:

- a. **Advantages:** Adds data to assist in uniquely identifying the transaction being rejected
